Staying safe

Rogue Traders

Our Trading Standards team works with other organisations to tackle 'rogue traders'. If you have any information about rogue traders we would like to know. Major Incidents

In an emergency, for example flooding, we work with other organisations to provide services to respond to major incidents and plan a response in advance. In Somerset we support people to remain as independent as possible and we promote independence and choice. As well as supporting adults of a working age we support older people who have disabilities, mental health needs and people who have a sensory loss.

We have a duty to try to protect adults aged 18 or above who may be at risk of abuse. If an adult is not able to protect themselves from abuse we call this safeguarding. Safeguarding means protecting a person's right to live safely, free from abuse and neglect.

If an adult is in immediate danger please call the emergency services on 999.

If you have concerns about an adult who you think may be suffering abuse, you can phone us on **0300 123 2224**.
