**It's completely free,  
and you'll receive:**



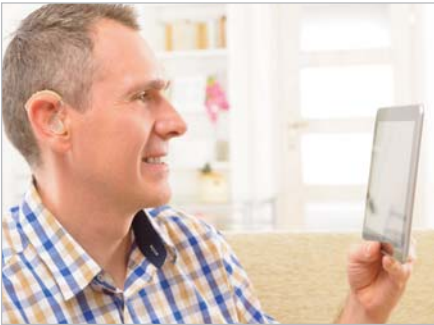
- Advanced notice of planned interruptions to your electricity supply.
- Advice on how to be prepared for a power cut, what to do if one happens and, if necessary, a cold weather crisis pack.
- A direct number to call to get straight through to the network operator in the event of an unplanned power cut.
- Special help, if needed, from the British Red Cross.

The PSR is a FREE service offered by Western Power Distribution (the company that runs the electricity network in the Midlands, South Wales and the South West).

# You can sign up to the Priority Services Register (PSR) if **any of these** apply to you:

- You receive a state pension
- You rely on electricity for medical reasons or for mobility equipment
- You have a hearing or visual impairment
- You have a disability or long term health condition
