



PUBLIC NOTICE

NORTH SOMERSET COUNCIL and SOMERSET COUNTY COUNCIL ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - Section 14 & Section 84 Final Notice of Temporary Traffic Regulation Order 2018 Weston Super Half Marathon

Various Roads, Footpaths and Bridleways, Weston-super-Mare (Temporary Prohibition of Use by Vehicles, Temporary Prohibition of Use by Pedestrians, Cyclists and Horseriders, Temporary Revocation of One Way and Temporary One Way, Temporary Loading and Waiting Restrictions and Temporary 20MPH Speed Limit) Order 2018 Date coming Into Force: 18th March 2018 for the Event and Date coming into Force for set up for the Event: 17th March 2018

Notice is hereby given that North Somerset Council and Somerset County Council in pursuance of the provisions of Section 14 & Section 84 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, have made an order the effect of which will be to close, temporarily, to vehicles in the lengths of roads specified in Schedule One and Six to this Notice. To temporarily prohibit the use by pedestrians, cyclists and horseriders in the various footpaths and bridleways as specified in the Schedule Two of this Notice. To implement, temporarily a revocation of the one way restriction and to implement, temporarily, one way traffic working in the length of roads specified in Schedule Three of this Notice. To temporarily prohibit any vehicle from loading and waiting in the lengths of roads in specified in Schedule Four of this Notice. To temporarily suspend the existing speed limit in favour of restricting temporarily any vehicle to 20MPH in the lengths of road specified in Schedule Five to this notice.

Exemptions for association with the event and authorised to do so under the direction of the event organiser and (a) a vehicle used by the fire brigade, police authority, or local authority for their respective purposes (b) an ambulance (c) a vehicle used by an Undertaker as defined in Part III of the New Roads and Street Works Act 1991 (d) a vehicle authorised in particular circumstances or for particular purposes by a police constable, a civil enforcement officer, a police community support officer, an official steward or marshal under the direction of the event organisers or (e) a vehicle which displays in a conspicuous position a written authorisation given by North Somerset Council, Somerset County Council or event organisers.

This order was required because of the likelihood of danger and a requirement for safety to the public and participants due to the Weston-Super- Half 2018 marathon (referred to as the 'Event'). This shall come into force on the 18th March 2018 for a maximum period of eighteen months for the Temporary Prohibition of Use by Vehicles, Temporary Revocation of One Way, Temporary One Way, Temporary Loading and Waiting Restrictions and Temporary 20MPH Speed Limit. For a maximum period of six months for the Temporary Prohibition of use by Pedestrians, cyclists and horseriders. However, the closures and restrictions may not be implemented for the whole of the period but only as necessitated by the event which is anticipated to be of one day from 06:30hrs to 13:30hrs in duration. For the set up of the Event on 17 March 2018 at Schedule Six for the Temporary Prohibition of use By Vehicles for a maximum period of eighteen months however the closure may not be implemented for the whole period and is anticipated to be two days in duration. Appropriate traffic signs will be displayed when the measures are in force.

SCHEDULE THREE

Burlington Street - for its entire length to temporarily revoke the one way order.

Uphill Road South to implement a one way order in a generally westerly direction from its junction with Uphill Way to its junction with Grange Road.

Bridgwater Road (A370) to implement a one way order in a generally northerly direction from its junction with Accommodation Road to its junction with Broadway.

SCHEDULE FOUR

Grange Road - for its entire length.

Upper Church Road - from Alfred Street to Orchard Street

Victoria Quadrant from property No 2 to property No 4

SCHEDULE FIVE

Bridgwater Road (A370) at its junction with Accommodation Road the speed restriction commences three hundred metres in a south easterly direction and continues to its junction with Grange Road.

SCHEDULE SIX

Princess Royal Square (Beach Road at its junction with Regent Street to its junctions with Richmond Street and Marine Parade).
