

**SOMERSET COUNTY COUNCIL
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984**

(as amended by the Road Traffic [Temporary Restriction] Act 1991)

WHEREAS THE COUNTY COUNCIL OF SOMERSET (hereinafter called "the Council") is the Highway Authority responsible for the maintenance and repair of

Steven's Lane, Lympsham for its entire length – Access to be Maintained.
The proposed start date is **21st June 2018 for 13 days**

Mudgley Road – East Brent for its entire length – Access to be Maintained.
The proposed start date is **5th July 2018 for 14 days**

Boat Lane, Lympsham for its entire length – Access to be Maintained. The proposed start date is **6th July 2018 for 13 days**

The Crescent, Lympsham for its entire length – Access to be Maintained.
The proposed start date is **6th July 2018 for 13 days**

Purving Row, Lympsham for its entire length – Access to be Maintained.
The proposed start date is **9th July 2018 for 11 days**

North Road, Lympsham for its entire length – Access to be Maintained. The proposed start date is **9th July 2018 for 11 days**

Slade Lane, Lympsham for its entire length – Access to be Maintained. The proposed start date is **10th July 2018 for 13 days**

Strowlands, Lympsham from its junction with Edingworth Road for a distance of 567 metres in a south westerly direction to its junction with Strowland Lane. The proposed start date is **9th July 2018 for 11 days**

in the Parishes of **LYMPSHAM AND EAST BRENT**
in the District of **SEDGEMOOR** in the County of Somerset (hereinafter referred to as "the said road");

AND WHEREAS the Council has given notice in pursuance of Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) of its intentions to make an Order PROHIBITING TEMPORARILY the use of a part of the said road by ALL VEHICULAR TRAFFIC:

NOW THEREFORE the Council in exercise of the powers conferred upon it by virtue of Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) HEREBY MAKES THE FOLLOWING ORDER:-

1. Save as hereinafter mentioned ALL TRAFFIC SHALL BE PROHIBITED from using that part of the said road, for a period not exceeding eighteen months in the first instance until the works being executed or proposed to be executed on or near the said road shall have been completed.

2. This Order is required to facilitate highway works and is necessary for the safety of the workforce whilst carrying out their duties. The restriction shall apply when indicated by traffic signs.
3. This Order shall come into operation on 7th **June 2018**
4. Nothing in this Order contained shall be deemed to prohibit all traffic from using the above-mentioned length of road EXCEPT THAT PART THEREOF UPON WHICH THE WORKS ARE BEING CARRIED OUT if such use is necessary
 - (i) for the conveyance of persons, goods or merchandise to or from any lands or premises situate on or adjacent to the length of road hereinbefore described; or
 - (ii) for the purpose of agriculture in connection with land adjoining or lying near to the length of the said road or for the conveyance or haulage of timber felled upon such land.

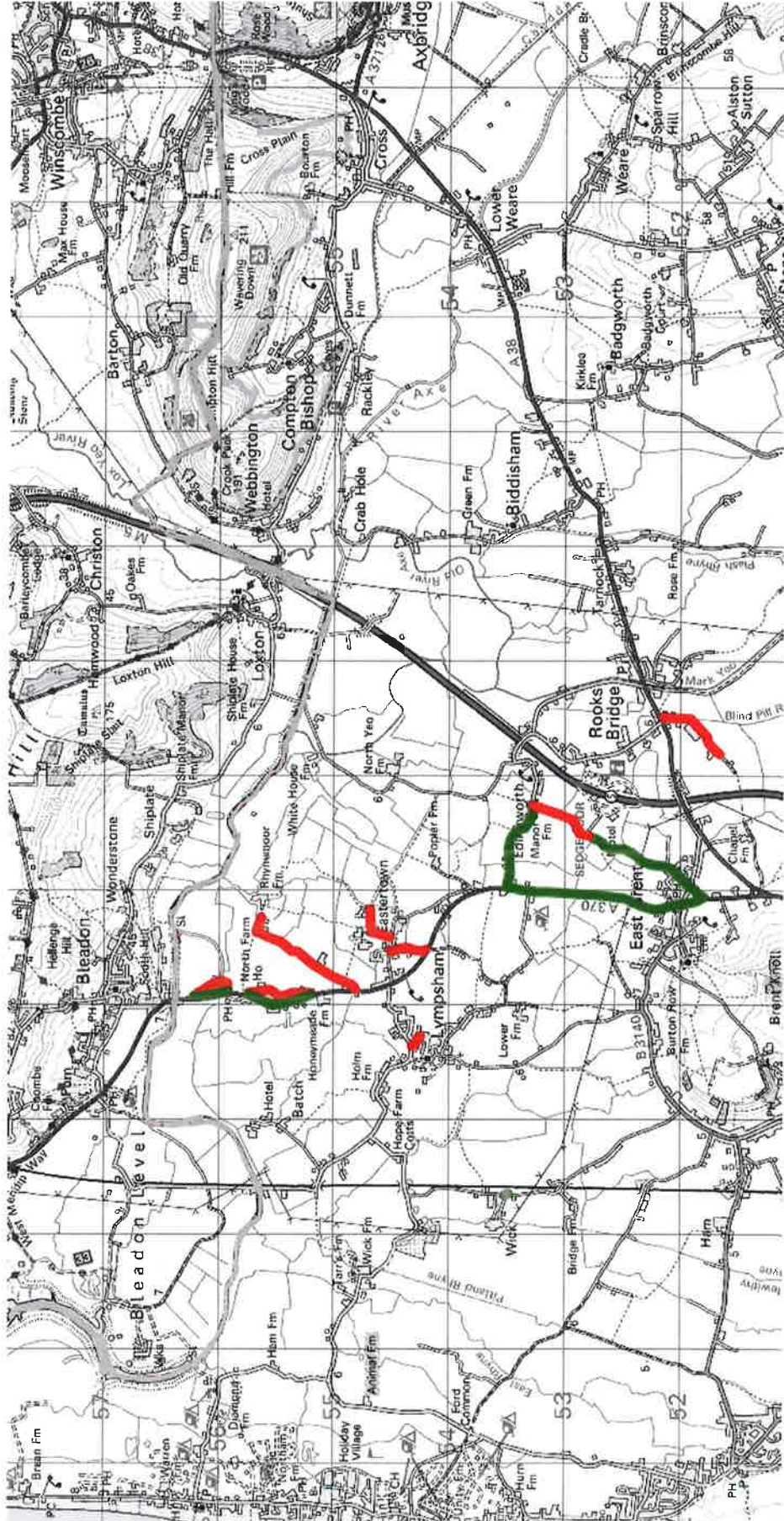
